A nonprofit, nondenominational child care center founded by Calvary Church, Calvary Place provides nurturing child care in a healthy, fun-filled environment for children ages six weeks to pre-kindergarten, Hospitality Hub is a ministry of the Downtown Churches association, shared with our homeless brothers and sisters, it offers: worship, spiritual guidance, traveler's aide, help getting birth certificates, driver's licenses and state ID's for employment, lockers, computer access, and good old-fashioned hospitality in the form of a cup of coffee and conversation, In the future the Hub may offer laundry services, Hunger Task Force, on each second Sunday of the month, volunteers sell soup and cornbread made by Calvary cooks. All profits go directly to feed hungry people, with monthly donations to the Food Bank, First Methodist Food Pantry, and the Street Ministry. In addition, Soup Sunday helps support the Ecumenical Peanut Butter Sandwich program: Calvary pays for supplies and delivers them to Plough Towers, where residents make sandwiches that are then distributed by St. Patrick's Catholic Church to the hungry of Memphis. Soup Sunday volunteers make two different soups from October to May on the Saturday preceding Soup Sunday. Calvary supports Lifeblood. Public Schools Partnership initiative provides support for two public schools (Carnes Elementary and Grizzlies Academy) including tutoring, book and backpack drives, faculty appreciation events, and shared dinners.
